## Biography of Roy Davis of Del Mar, CA

"Ellie Brown is modeled on and named after my mother who I remember directing a bulldozer driver during the construction of the local school. She managed the whole project and is the source of my engineering abilities," He went on to say.

Roy wrote the *Digital Dave* weekly computer advice column in *ComputorEdge Magazine* for 25 years, reaching a peak readership of 350,000. A compendium of *Digital Dave* was published in book form in four languages and garnered awards.

Roy earned a degree in Electrical Engineering with a minor in mass media, serving as an editor of the University of Wisconsin – Milwaukee newspaper. An opinion piece of his was republished in the Milwaukee Sentinel, then became the preamble of the state law it addressed.
